as part of the Elite Graduate Program “Theoretical and Mathematical Physics”

commencing on 1 October 2012

The primary tasks of the successful candidate include research and teaching in theoretical high energy physics, in particular elementary particle physics, string theory, cosmology, gauge theories and quantum gravity. The successful applicant is expected to participate in the activities of the Elite Graduate Program “Theoretical and Mathematical Physics” as well as in the teaching of the department of physics.

Prerequisites for this position are a university degree, teaching skills and an aptitude for an academic career, usually evidenced by the excellent quality of a doctoral degree. If the applicant was employed as a research assistant either before or after obtaining the doctoral degree, the entire duration of the period of employment and of the doctoral degree should not exceed six years.

The position is a fixed-term professorship for the duration of three years. Pending a positive evaluation, the position may be extended by another period up to of two years. A conversion to an indefinite position (tenure track) is not possible.

The University of Munich is an equal opportunity employer and aims to increase the number of female faculty members. Therefore, applications from female candidates are explicitly encouraged.

Disabled candidates with essentially equal qualifications will be given preference.
